Coronavirus Update - Temporary Practice Closure

This was a difficult decision to make and we are aware that it comes with significant consequences for our clients. We also have ultimate confidence that we are taking the most appropriate measures to maintain everyone's safety, and that we will be able to support our clients through this difficult time.

The Wake Kendall Group has been working diligently to prepare for this closure, including ensuring that all of our clinicians have access to secure technology by which to conduct individual therapy remotely by video.
